

The Jobs Base can help you find new recruits for your organisation.

The “Jobs Base” has been set up to put BNSSG care providers in touch with sponsored care workers who are looking for a new job. This might be because their employer’s licence has been suspended or revoked, or because their employer couldn’t provide enough hours.

Often they will have worked in care services in this country for a little while and have valuable skills and experience to benefit your business.

What do I need to do?

It's very simple. You add the roles you want to fill to the Jobs Base for your local area and then the Jobs Base will share your details with sponsored care workers looking for a new role and sponsor.

Care workers who are interested will contact you directly (with a unique reference number). You then assess their applications in the usual way.

Do make the most of this opportunity to find care workers who could make a really positive contribution to your business and the people you care for.

Please only post a vacancy on the Jobs Base if you have a sponsor licence.

What is the DASS process?

All displaced workers will need a Certificate of Sponsorship (CoS) from your CoS allocation. If all your current allocation are used - you will need to apply for a new CoS to sponsor the displaced worker.

Your local authority may be able to support and expedite your new CoS request, directly with the Home Office/UKVI via their DASS process. Contact your local authority Adult Social Care team to discuss.

What do displaced workers do?
